

Gonzalo Smith has been the VP & General Counsel of Walmart Latin America since 2009. He heads the Legal Department of Walmart for all countries in the Region, which include Argentina, Brazil, Chile, Mexico and Central America. With four market General Counsels reporting directly to him and over 100 lawyers throughout the region, he leads legal matters in nine national jurisdictions including both operational and transactional aspects. Gonzalo Smith is licensed to practice law in North Carolina and in Chile. He holds an LL.B. from Pontificia Universidad Católica de Chile, an LL.M. from Harvard Law and is expected to receive his MBA in June of 2015 from the University of Arkansas. Prior to joining Walmart International Gonzalo Smith was the General Counsel, Ethics Officer and Corporate Secretary of Walmart Chile for five years. Prior to that he was in private practice for ten years with Carey y Cía., Chile's largest law firm, focusing mostly on the practice of securities law, corporate law, M&A and banking and finance legal issues. During that period he was also a foreign associate with Davis Polk & Wardwell in its New York City office for a year and a foreign associate with Cuatrecasas in Madrid for 18 months. Gonzalo Smith has also been a Professor of Commercial Law and Jurisprudence at the Law School of Pontificia Universidad Católica de Chile as well as a Teaching Assistant of Economic Law at Universidad de Chile, of Jurisprudence at Pontificia Universidad Católica de Chile and of Procedural Law at Pontificia Universidad Católica de Chile and Universidad Nacional Andrés Bello in Chile. He was also a Fulbright grantee while pursuing his LL.M. at Harvard Law.
